- Vaccine depending on the life style of puppy.
- After Puppy shots - vaccine booster - every year
- Do NOT take him/her outside until all rounds of puppy vaccine are done.
- Fleas/Ticks Preventive: Once a month
- Deworming every 3 to 6 months depending on life style.
- Routine Dental care
- Routine Ear care
- Behavior
- ✓ Puppy food until 9 months of age.
- ✓ Start Adult food along with puppy food from 9 months.
- ✓ After 1 year of age, adult food only.

<p><b>DAPP:</b> Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus</p> <p><b>Why this vaccine is important:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Distemper is a highly infective respiratory disease and often fatal.</li> <li>• Parvovirus cause potentially fatal gastrointestinal disease.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Leptospirosis:</b></p> <p><b>Why this vaccine is important:</b></p> <p>Disease can lead to rapid organ failure and can be transferred directly from pets to humans, primarily via urine</p>
<p><b>Bordetella / Kennel Cough:</b></p> <p><b>Why this vaccine is important:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bordetella is highly infective respiratory disease that can cause significant coughing and occasionally secondary pneumonia</li> </ul>	<p><b>Rabies:</b></p> <p><b>Why this vaccine is important:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rabies is almost 100% fatal in pets and humans</li> <li>• Most cities have legal requirements for rabies vaccinations.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Lyme:</b></p> <p><b>Why this vaccine is important:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lyme Disease can be difficult to diagnosis and can lead to kidney disease, as well as to chronic joint pain and arthritis</li> </ul>
